



- CROSS OUT THE WORDS THAT YOU KNOW IT CAN'T BE
 - REPLACE THE WORD WITH A SYNONYM

• MANY INFERENCE
QUESTIONS START WITH THE
5 Ws OR HOW

• YOU'RE NOT LOOKING FOR WHAT IS THERE — YOU'RE LOOKING FOR WHAT IS MEANT BY IT

• ACTIONS GIVE CLUES ABOUT FEELINGS

 LOOK FOR HINTS AT WHAT MIGHT HAPPEN NEXT

YOUR PREDICTION NEEDS TO BE LOGICAL
 AND REASONABLE BASED ON THE TEXT

• WHAT HAS THE AUTHOR IMPLIED THROUGH LANGUAGE CHOICES?

• THINK ABOUT SIMILARITIES AND DIFFERENCES

- IMAGINE THAT YOU ARE THE AUTHOR OF THE TEXT WHY DID YOU MAKE THAT VOCABULARY CHOICE?
 - READ THE START AND END OF THE TEXT WHAT CHANGES TAKE PLACE?

- THE ANSWER IS ALWAYS
 IN THE TEXT
- DO NOT PUT THE ANSWER IN YOUR OWN WORDS JUST COPY IT!
- READ THE PIECE OF TEXT THE QUESTION IS ASKING YOU ABOUT
 - CAREFULLY READ THE TEXT AGAIN

• PICK OUT ONLY THE KEY POINTS

• SUMMARISING IS USED TO GIVE A GENERAL OVERVIEW OF SOMETHING

• FOR ORDERING EVENTS, GO
BACK TO THE START OF THE TEXT
TO CHECK
